RINGING OF THE BIRDS 2025

Ringling of the flamingoes in Fuente de Piedra began in 1986. It involves marking the flamingoes with plastic rings with digits that can be read from a distance using a telescope.

This marking enables individual monitoring of the birds and the study of aspects of their biology such as population statistics, usage of the various wetlands, reproductive behaviour, mortality etc.

The information obtained is important for the management of the reproductive colony and to evaluate the usage of the Andalusian wetlands.

The fact that the young birds can't yet fly means they are easy to herd into corrals right next to the breeding grounds. Around 300 volunteers, mostly from all over Spain, but also from abroad, are trusted with this delicate operation.

In this section we list questions put forward by our team and answers received..

Town Hall representation in the Realenga

Last year we asked when the Town Hall would open an office in the Realenga.

Is it happening yet?

If not, when? **REPLY: The mayor states that the office exists and is used for meetings etc., but nothing more.**

Payments in cash

We are aware of payments made by municipal workers. How does the City Council ensure that the money is deposited into the City Council's current accounts? **REPLY: Mr. Alberto Soto explains that users who request it are given a receipt, and once a month the monitor deposits the money into the account.**

Transparency

A year ago we presented a petition requesting compliance with the law regarding transparency.

Although it was promised ASAP, it still looks to be a long way off.

One excuse was that our town hall is a small operation (although the salaries add up to an appreciable sum) but they would do what they could. Following on:

- ¿When will the town hall's transparency portal be updated? **REPLY: Cristóbal Fernández states that, as reported the other day by the secretary, there are actually two transparency portals and all the relevant minutes have been uploaded.**

There you have the response. **TRANSPARENCY?.**

LOCAL ISSUES

Local people are very concerned about issues such as street cleaning, maintenance etc. and when they complain to the town hall, they often have to wait months or even years before receiving a reply.

Our group has submitted several written complaints regarding the state of empty plots, problems with rubbish containers, safety issues and faulty street lighting, to name but a few.

Fortunately these efforts have borne fruit and problems have been rectified. So we hereby invite all those who are aware of problems to let us know. We can get results.

Food Bank.

¿How does the food distribution mechanism work?

What are the criteria for prioritising distribution?

How are the potential recipients prioritised? We would also like to know:

Where do the goods come from?

What controls are in place? (Storage, expiry dates, hygiene etc.).

How is delivery controlled?

REPLY: Yolanda González Diaz, social services councillor, explains that the food bank is managed in collaboration with Bancosol. Applicants present the relevant documentation in the town hall and this is passed on to Málaga Social Services, who emit a report based on the family situation. The list of recipients is then created according to priority. Products are catalogued and revised by Bancosol. Products are not out of date, but close to it, given that they are donated by the large distributors. A document detailing the products is raised and signed by both parties.

Proposals.

Energy proposal.

In the plenary session of May 2024, we presented an energy proposal that was **REJECTED** because the local government was already implementing a better solution. We asked how this project was coming along. The mayor reports that the project has been put on hold pending a revaluation.

More than a year later and **NOTHING. ON TRACK?**

PROPOSAL FOR DEBATE REGARDING TRAFFIC FLOW

Our group presents a proposal regarding traffic flow. Many local people have mobility issues. They do not have unrestricted safe access to the town hall offices.

Our proposal is aimed at a short term solution, not a project for the future.

We believe that this proposal can be implemented without great expense and would facilitate safe access to the town hall for everyone, including families with babies. Currently they have to put themselves at risk mixing with the traffic.

We ask that a space be reserved in the parking area to give protected access, at least until a longer term solution can be implemented.

On the subject of traffic, many residents complain of feeling vulnerable while negotiating the junction of PLAZA DE LA CONSTITUCIÓN, CALLE RAÚL DEL POZO AND CALLE LA RODA.

We believe that the problem has a practical and rapid solution at very little cost. This would be a simple traffic island/roundabout with some form of control, making the busy intersection at the heart of the town a little safer to navigate.

Summing up, our group puts forward the following suggestions for approval:

FIRST - That the town hall create the aforementioned space, as soon as possible, to facilitate easier access in Calle Ancha for people with reduced mobility.

SECOND - The town hall implement the required traffic control at the bottom of the town square.

THIRD - The town hall to study possible options for both projects.

From this moment on there are activities all over the town. These involve wine, painting contest for children etc. But at 6pm everyone gathers in Calle Ancha for the horse racing. It starts with the parade of the "manolas" (girls in traditional costume). A band accompanies the spectacle. The only people not present are those that are dressing the virgin for the procession. After the race is over, the virgin is ready for her procession around the town.

The procession leaves at 10pm. The procession is full of emotional moments and reaches its climax when the virgin is returned to her church until next year.
